**TEMPORARY AUTHORITY**

**Section 136 Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012  
OFF-Licence for Premises**

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Dhesi Holdings Limited** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **50 Shotover Street, Queenstown** and known as "Queenstown Liquor Centre" in accordance with the conditions of the underlying OFF-licence no: **68/OFF/0346/2018**

The holder of a Temporary Authority shall for the purposes of the Act have the same duties, obligations and liabilities as the holder of the **OFF** licence to which the Temporary Authority relates.

The authority conferred by this licence shall be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

**CONDITIONS**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
- b) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made:
  - i) On the premises; or
  - ii) From grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated.
- c) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

**Monday to Sunday 7.00 am to 11.00 pm**
- d) The whole of the premises is designated as a supervised area in accordance with the plans of the premises submitted to the District Licensing Committee on 9<sup>th</sup> March 2012 and 6<sup>th</sup> May 2019.
- e) According to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol (Fees) Regulations 2013 the premises is assigned the fees category: **High – Bottle Store**.

**DURATION**

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence is in force from:

- (a) **10<sup>th</sup> July 2020** until the **10<sup>th</sup> October 2020** or until such date as the holder's application for an off-licence has been determined, whichever is the sooner.
- (b) If the Temporary Authority is renewed, until the close of the period for which it is renewed.
