

OFF-LICENCE
32/OFF/4992/2026
Sections 17, 18, 19 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the **Act**), **A&H Liquor Limited** (the Licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at **39 Hakiaha Street, Taumarunui (State Highway 4)**, and known as "**Super Liquor**", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. If this Licence is not endorsed under Section 40 of the Act, the Licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a Manager or Managers appointed by the Licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) Alcohol may be sold and supplied only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 9.00 am to 10.00 pm.
- (b) No alcohol is to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
- (c) The area where alcohol is to be sold is described in the plan date stamped as received by the District Licensing Committee on 17 March 2026.
- (d) The entire premises is designated as a supervised area (no persons under 18 can be in the area unless with their parent or legal guardian).
- (e) A properly appointed certificated, acting or temporary manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
- (f) A manager's register (as required by s.232 of the Act) is to be maintained and available on site.
- (g) A Host Responsibility Policy must be maintained and displayed at all points of sale and the Licensee must ensure all staff receives training in their responsibilities and obligations under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
- (h) There must be no sale or supply of alcohol to minors or intoxicated persons and there must be displayed at every point of sale appropriate signs detailing these restrictions.
- (i) Drinking water must be freely available and displayed whenever alcohol is being supplied by way of complimentary tastings.
- (j) The Licensee must ensure the following are displayed:
 - (i) A sign to be seen from outside the principle entrance at 39 Hakiaha Street, Taumarunui (State Highway 4) stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for the sale of alcohol.
 - (ii) A copy of the original licence with all the conditions, just inside the principle entrance at 39 Hakiaha Street, Taumarunui (State Highway 4) so persons entering can read it.
 - (iii) A sign in a prominent place identifying the duty manager.

REMOTE SALES

- (k) Alcohol must not be delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day, or between 11:00pm and 6:00am the following day.
- (l) The licensee must take reasonable steps to verify that the buyer and the receiver of an alcohol delivery is not under 18 years of age, and that the receiver (where present) is not intoxicated.
- (m) A copy of the licence must be displayed on the Super Liquor Taumarunui internet site in a prominent place.
